## Fencing Projects

- This program is for exclusion fencing, intended for the exclusion of livestock from waterways/dugouts. This program does not cover perimeter fencing.
- SRRWD will reimburse $\$ 1.25$ per foot for fencing plus $\$ 90$ per corner and $\$ 150$ for a Solar Electric Fencer. (This covers $75 \%$ of the cost of materials and installation for two-strand electric fence with 40 ft . post spacing.)
- Producers are not required to use electric fencing but additional costs will not be covered by SRRWD without special approval
