- This program provides funding, for producers who have fenced off water courses/dugouts, to purchase pumping equipment for watering livestock. **Producers who have not yet fenced off the water course or dugout can also apply for our fencing program (see below).**
- The alternative watering for **waterways** program cost-share will be 85% SRRWD 15% landowner with a SRRWD maximum contribution of \$7500.00.
- The alternative watering for **dugouts** program cost-share will be 85% SRRWD 15% landowner with a SRRWD maximum contribution of \$5,000.00.

- For those who have a watering system far away from their home site, we are offering funding to cover the purchase of a trail camera to monitor the site.
- SRRWD will cover 85% for the purchase, monthly prescriptions are the responsibility of the land owner.

Fencing Projects

- This program is for exclusion fencing, intended for the exclusion of livestock from waterways/dugouts. **This program does not cover perimeter fencing.**
- SRRWD will reimburse \$1.25 per foot for fencing plus \$90 per corner and \$150 for a Solar Electric Fencer. (This covers 75% of the cost of materials and installation for two-strand electric fence with 40 ft. post spacing.)
- Producers are not required to use electric fencing but additional costs will not be covered by SRRWD without special approval

- Waterways must be fenced off prior to crossing being installed, producers can apply to our Fencing program above
- The Livestock crossing program cost-share will be 75% SRRWD, 25% landowner with a maximum SRRWD contribution of \$1000.00.

The SRRWD will determine application priorities in consultation with sub-district members, Board and staff. **All projects must be approved by the SRRWD Board prior to construction and/or installation, with a signed project agreement in place.**

The Landowner is to design the project in cooperation with the SRRWD staff and/or other partner organizations. The Landowner will perform necessary maintenance following the completion of the project and agrees to leave the project in place for a minimum of 10 years, and to not alter, change, remove or modify the project without the written consent of the SRRWD. After 10 years, all materials purchased and/or installed will become the property of the landowner.
